The Club

Comprising a triple height atrium, the ground floor restaurant remains open to the public, whilst up above, the *Piano Nobile*, literally the noble floor, remains the sole preserve of members. Here, recessed from the balustraded balcony, you will find the the heart of the Club, the magnificent Long Bar with its *fin de siècle* grandeur, the colonial-style Snooker Room, and Board Room, each furnished to the most exacting standards and befitting those who demand the utmost in service.

Finally, the crowning glory, Gracy's Roof Gardens, affording seasonal dining beneath the stars and overlooking views of Valletta's historic skyline.





Interiors

The interior, designed by the club's Creative Director Samantha Rowe-Beddoe, combines a rich and sophisticated palette of vibrant wall coverings, upholstery, handmade chairs and sofas and beautiful bespoke bars.

From its sumptuous powder rooms to its bespoke booths, its stunning roof top VIP area (offering the best views of Valletta) and a huge internal glass window that allows diners to see into the kitchen run by Executive Chef Tom Peters, the club is architecturally stunning.

No expense has been spared sourcing fixtures and fittings, lighting and décor from Europe's finest design houses including Rubelli, GP & J Baker, Pierre Frey, Vaughan, William Yeoward, Porta Romana and Andrew Martin.

A home away from home, members can work, play and relax in the height of comfort with like-minded individuals. The exclusive list of founder members were personally invited to create a balanced mix of men and women of all ages. Expect to rub shoulders with an international crowd from the worlds of business, politics, art and entertainment.





Private Members' Club

Gracy's private members' club, the Arts & Supper Club, offers guests a unique and memorable location in which to work or relax. The club occupies the upper floors of the Palazzo Verdelin, comprising the *fin de siècle* Long Bar, a spacious first floor clubroom and bar, whose furnishings recall the golden age of luxury travel. With sweeping views across Valletta's central square our members can meet for coffee or cocktails and our lunch and dinner menus are also available here.

With a nod to the building's sporting heritage there is the Snooker Room boasting a full-size table left behind, but not forgotten, as the sun finally set on the British Empire – as well as the delightfully named Ping-Pong Room with a bespoke table that doubles up seamlessly for private dining or board meetings depending on our members' requirements.

A third salon, the Ladies Meeting Room, plays host to smaller events and our library is filled with complimentary international magazines and offers office facilities. Intimate tables on the Piano Nobile's balustraded balcony double up as chess and backgammon boards.

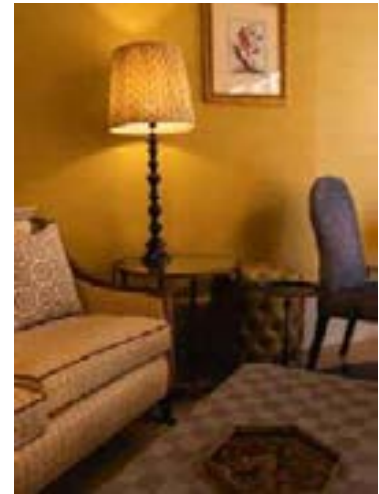

As a member no room fee or minimum spend will apply for normal day bookings.









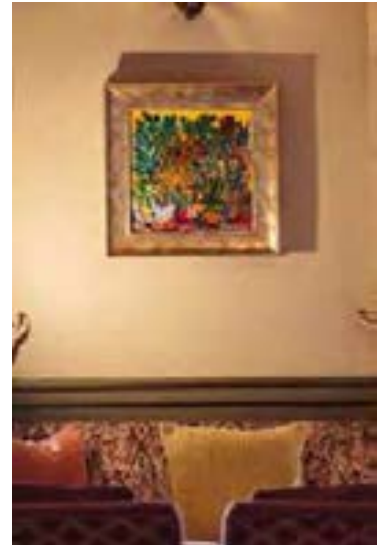


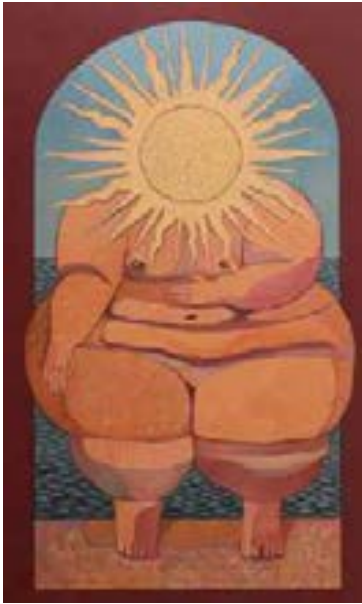
Art

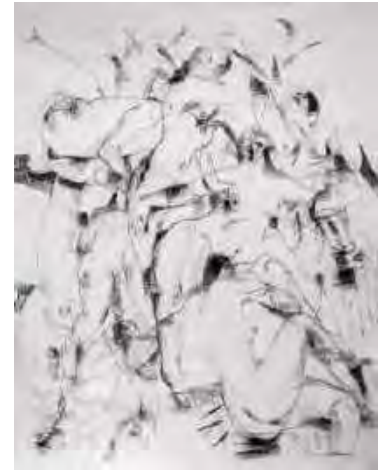
